## Your rights in the personal data protection

**Right of access** – you have the right to be provided with a copy of the personal data we hold about you, as well as information about how we use your personal data. In most cases, your personal data will be provided to you in written document form, unless you request another way of providing them. If you have requested the provision of this information by electronic means, it will be provided to you electronically if it is technically possible.

**Right to correction** – we take reasonable measures to ensure the accuracy, completeness and timeliness of the information we have about you. If you think that the data we hold is inaccurate, incomplete or out of date, please do not hesitate to ask us to correct, update or supplement this information.

**Right to deletion (to be forgotten)** – you have the right to ask us to delete your personal data, for example in case, if the personal data we have obtained about you are no longer necessary to fulfill the original purpose of processing. However, your right must be assessed in light of all the relevant circumstances. For example, we may have certain legal and regulatory obligations which mean that we will not be able to comply with your request.

**Right to restriction of processing** – under certain circumstances, you are entitled to ask us to stop using your personal data. These are, for example, cases when you think that the personal data we have about you may be inaccurate or when you think that we no longer need to use your personal data.

**The right to data portability** – under certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to transfer the personal data you have provided to us to another third party of your choice. However, the right to portability only applies to personal data that we have obtained from you on the basis of consent or on the basis of a contract to which you are one of the parties.

**Right to object** – you have the right to object to data processing which is based on our legitimate rightful interests. In the case if we do not have a compelling legitimate rightful reason for processing and you file an objection, we will not process your personal data further.
